It has come to our attention that other individuals and entities are approaching our customers with proposals to provide composite training services at customer facilities. They may be claiming that they are representatives of Abaris, former employees, or doing business under another name.

We have discovered that these individuals have stolen Abaris' intellectual property (IP) such as course descriptions, slide presentations, illustrations, and general training materials, and that they may be republishing these under their own banner in violation of federal law (18 U.S.C. § 1832). Our course descriptions are published on our website at: <https://portal.abaris.com/courses?filter=R>.

All of this is under investigation by the authorities, and we are notifying you to keep your eyes out for these criminal aspirants, as we do not want to see your business or organization affected by this scam. We encourage you to contact us if you are approached by any of these people. True representatives of Abaris will have an abaris.com domain email address and use the published phone numbers found on our website and in the signature blocks below.
